# What is Family Medicine?

- Is the medical specialty which provides continuing, comprehensive health care for the individual and family.
- The Institute of Medicine defines primary care as "the provision of integrated, accessible health care services by clinicians who are accountable for addressing a large majority of personal health care needs, developing a sustained partnership with patients, and practicing in the context of family and community."



# **Scope of Family Medicine**

- Family physicians integrate the biological, clinical and behavioral sciences to provide continuing and comprehensive health care.
- Family medicine encompasses all ages, sexes, each organ system and every disease entity.
- It is the extent to which this relationship is valued, developed, nurtured and maintained that distinguishes family medicine from all other specialties.
- Of the primary care specialties family physicians provide the most care - managing nearly 1/4 of all primary care visits.

## What does it look like?

- Understanding community-level factors and social determinants of health
- Serving as a patient's first contact for health concerns
- Navigating the health care system with patients, including specialist and hospital care coordination and follow-up
- Using data and technology to coordinate services and enhance care
- Considering the impact of health on a patient's family




# **Ambulatory Continuity Care Clinics**
