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#### Resume

Dr. Maldonado is a native of Adjuntas, Puerto Rico. His father, Herminio was a farmer. His mother Esther was Romanian. He has a brother Leonard also a physician. He studied in the public schools of his hometown and then went to Ponce High School graduating in 1952. He received his Bachelors in Arts degree from Polytechnic Institute in San German and his medical doctor from the University of Puerto Rico School of Medicine in 1959. He interned in D.C. General Hospital in Washington, D.C. and did his Residency in Internal Medicine at University Hospital in San Juan. He did his fellowship in hematology at University Hospital and at the New England Medical Center in Boston. He served in the U.S. Medical Corps as Captain in Germany from 1962 tol 963.

He was Director of Hematology at the University Hospital of the University of Puerto Rico from 1966 to 1973. During those years he did clinical research in tropical sprue and the treatment leukemia and hematologic malignancies. He was appointed Medical Director of San Juan City Hospital from 1973 to 1976. In 1977 he was appointed Undersecretary of Health for Puerto Rico and had the responsibility to be in charge of the entire government run system with health centers in every municipality and 15 hospitals.

In 1978 he was appointed Chancellor of the Medical Sciences Campus of the University of Puerto Rico which had 82 separate academic programs. During his tenure all academic programs were accredited and over 1 ,OOO students graduated yearly. An intramural practice plan was begun and the Carolina Area Hospital became a mayor teaching hospital for the Medical School. The Intramural Practice Plan and the self insured Medical Malpractice Plan was created. The Deferred Compensation Plan was implemented.

He returned to teaching in 1985 and was the coordinator of the UPR Medical School Internal Medicine Residency program. He organized teaching activities to improve the performance of the residents in the Board Examinations by using the American College of Physicians MKSP study program. He is the author and co-author of over fifty peer review publications in his field of hematology and medical oncology. He has recently published a book," History of Health in Puerto Rico".

He was the founder and director of an office for planning in the Puerto Rico Senate from 1993 -94 which evaluated all the legislation submitted for approval with a staff of some 15 consultants. He was appointed advisor to the Governor of Puerto Rico on Health Reform in 1993 and led a group of 300 health professionals and civic leaders in

transforming our health care system. Her participated actively in the Clinton Health Reform project to include Puerto Rico.

and 1994 he was appointed President of the University of Puerto Rico System with 11 canouses, a position he held for 7 years. During his tenure, student enrollment increased from 53,000 to 70,000 students. He acquired the Carolina Area Hospital and turned it into the University of Puerto Rico Hospital. Libraries and sport facilities were built or remodeled in all campuses. He was a member of the Board of Directors of the National Association of State Universities and Land Grant Colleges, the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (HACU) and President of UNICA, the Association of Caribbean Universities. Graduation increased from 8,000 to 10,000 students every year and 25 new academic programs were created. The Regional College System was abolished and all 6 Campuses became autonomous. An Endowment Fund was created and the first endowed chairs were funded. He went twice to the Bond Market to expand facilities in all campuses. An Annual Report was printed informing the internal and external community of our achievements and financial status.

He has served for many years in the Board of the American Red Cross and the Red Cross Blood Bank. He has had a limited private practice, has the rank of Professor of Medicine and dedicates ten hours weekly to teaching fellows, residents and medical students in the UPR Medical School. He is a member of the Board of Trustees of Universidad Central del Caribe. Since 1998 has been a Member of the National Committee on Foreign Medical Education and Accreditation of the Federal Department of Education serving a third term.

He is a diplomate of the American Board of Internal Medicine and of the Amercing Board of Internal Medicine in Hematology. He has been a Fellow of the American College of Physicians since 1971. He was the first recipient of ACP Puerto Rico Chapter Laureate Award. In 2007 he was promoted to Master of the American College of Physicians.

He is the Secretary General of the Interamerican Division of the International Society of Hematology. He is a member of the Puerto Rican Association of Hematology and Medical Oncology and president of the Scientific Committee. He was the President of San Juan Rotary Club for the year 2007-08, the oldest club in Latin America founded in 1918. He is a member of the advisory committee of MMM.

He is married to Mary Anne Maldonado, has 5 children: Norman, Michael, Maria, Luis, and Ana. He has four grandchildren; Giovanni, Camelia, Alexander Jerome and Peter Herminio.
