Requirements for Admission



- Graduates of School of Medicine approved by the LCME:
 - Fill out the NRMP application
 - Fill out duplicate application for programs provided by the GME office
 - Official transcripts of institution were premedical studies were done
 - Official transcript from Medical School
 - Dean's letter from the Medical School including ranking in class and narrative description of your qualifications
 - Two letters of recommendation from professors from the Medical School
 - Official evidence of having approved the USMLE part 1
 - Full domain of Spanish and English

Requirements for Admission



- Foreign Medical School Graduates
 - Follow items 1 to 6 at previous page
 - Copy of Medical School Diploma
 - Official evidence of USMLE parts 1 and 2
 - Valid ECFMG certificate
 - Appropriate visas if needed
 - Full domain of written and spoken Spanish and English

- PGY-1: 1-2 clinic session / week (6 patients / clinic)
- PGY-2: average of 2-4 clinic sessions / week (10 patients/clinic)
- PGY-3: average of 2-4 clinic sessions / week (12 patients/clinic)

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AVERAGE NIGHT CALLS



- PGY-1: every 5th day
- PGY-2: every 14th day
- PGY-3: Pager calls, every 16th week
- Research: Required
