- 1. Personal Statement in Spanish (in addition to English version). (send the Personal Statement in Spanish to zoraida.perez@upr.edu)
- 2. Two official College Transcripts (with your cumulative average grade point-GPA).
- 3. Official copy of your Diploma of Medical School. **
- 4. Among letters of recommendation addressed to Training Director at least one should be from clinical rotation supervisor.
 - a. Candidates who graduate more than one year prior to the application must submit a letter of recommendation from most recent employment/clinical work experience.
- 5. Compliance with the UPR-School of Medicine Graduate Medical Education Office requirements.**
- 6. Official evidence of having approved USMLE Part I and USMLE Part II CK of the USMLE. The Candidate must have approved the USMLE-Step II CK no later than one week before the NRMP raking closing date. (February 12, 2010).***
- 7. Provisional or permanent License to practice Medicine in Puerto Rico. **
- 8. <u>Official</u> Evidence of the Registration for the National Residency Matching Program (NRMP). (send the evidence to zoralda.perez @upr.edu)
- 9. Fully bilingual Spanish/English (Fluency in speaking, reading, comprehension and writing in both languages).
- 10. PGY II level candidates must also include: (a) a letter of recommendation in English from the Training Director of the Program stating the clinical rotations and exact dates of each clinical rotation completed in the PGY I training level; (b) official evidence of having approved USMLE Part I and Part II (CK and CS).; (c) USMLE Part III is highly recommended.
