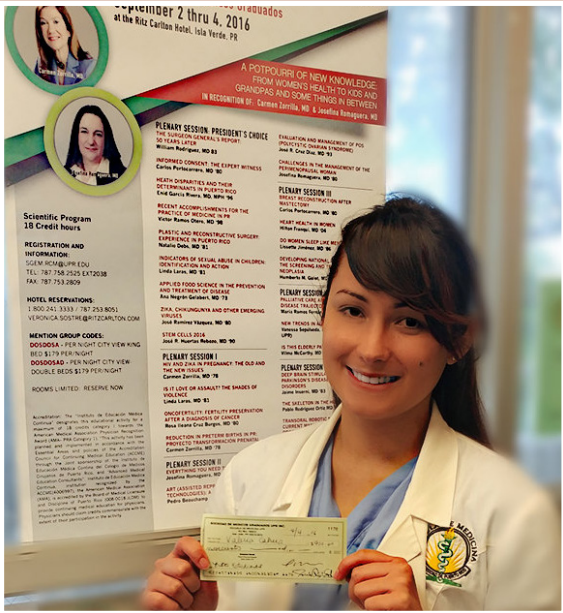
Dr. Judith Román, neurologist and prominent faculty member for many years will be also honored with a special mention for her contribution to our school.
